Eighth grade has jumped right into SE Hinton's novel, <u>The Outsiders</u>, about rival gangs in 1965 Oklahoma. This book was a favorite of mine in school and seems to be a new favorite of much of this group. It has prompted some great conversations about stereotypes and perceptions. Given the sad ending of this novel, students were given the opportunity to rewrite the ending of the story however they saw fit. We also watched the movie version and evaluated how well it stayed true to the story presented in the novel.
