Assignment Details

- (a) **Draw a map of the US.** Draw an outline of the US and fill in as many states as you can! Include state capitals, as well. Take a picture of your drawing and share it with me.
- (b) **World History!** The first World War was a significant turning point in world history. Check out this [site](#) to understand what caused the first world war. Write out ten facts that you learn.
- (c) **April Showers Bring...** The Mayflower journey was a pretty rough one for all of the travelers. Check out this [site](#) to learn about what it was like to travel overseas in this important ship. Write down ten facts that you learned.
- (d) **The Great Escape!** Alcatraz was meant to be a place where escape was impossible, so it became home to the most notorious criminals. Learn about four of the worst [here](#) and tell me who you find to be most interesting and why.
- (e) **The History of Me!** Create a timeline of your life. Start with the day you were born and add in at least ten important events that have happened since that day. Be sure to include the dates of the events and put them in the correct order on your timeline. Add some drawings to make it colorful!
- (f) **The Constitution.** Our entire country is built around the ideas outlined in The Constitution. Learn about this important document [here](#) and write ten facts that you learn.
- (g) **Wild Card!** Which event in US history do you find to be the most interesting? Do a bit of research and write twelve facts about it!
- (h) **All About Lake Erie!** Lake Erie is the fourth largest of the Great Lakes. Check out this [site](#) to learn more about it. Write down ten facts that you learned.
- (i) **Scarface!** One of the most fascinating residents of Alcatraz was Al Capone. Learn about him [here](#) and write down ten facts that you learned.
- (j) **Amber Waves of Grain!** The US is known for its great farmland, which explains the large number of farms that are currently operating in our country. But farming doesn't come without difficulties. Learn more about the history of farming [here](#) and write eight things that you learned.
- (k) **Change the World!** Kid President wants you to help change the world. Choose one important thing and write a solid paragraph telling about how you would make that happen if you were president.

(For two of the continents, this won't be possible so for those two, write three things that the continent is known for.) Additionally, write an alphabetical list of the four named oceans in the world.
