Assignment Details

- (a) **Draw a map of the US.** Draw an outline of the US and fill in as many states as you can! Take a picture of your drawing and share it with me.
- (b) **US History!** Without the American Revolution, we would probably not be our own country today. Check out this [video](#) and write down eight facts that you learned.
- (c) **April Showers Bring...** The Mayflower brought 102 Pilgrims to the US in the 1600s. Draw a picture of what the ship looked like using [this site](#) as a reference.
- (d) **The Great Escape!** The story of the Anglin brothers is one of the most well-known of all Alcatraz escapes. Check out this [link](#) and write ten facts about this event.
- (e) **The History of Me!** Create a timeline of your life. Start with the day you were born and add in at least ten important events that have happened since that day. Be sure to include the dates of the events and put them in the correct order on your timeline. Add some drawings to make it colorful!
- (f) **Well, I Do Declare!** One of the most important documents in our country is the Declaration of Independence. Check out this [video](#) and write eight facts about this document.
- (g) **Wild Card!** Which event in US history do you find to be the most interesting? Do a bit of research and write ten facts about it!
- (h) **All About Lake Huron!** Lake Huron is the second largest great lake. Check out this [site](#) and write eight facts about it.
- (i) **Party Time!** The Boston Tea Party was unlike any other party ever thrown. Check out this [video](#) to learn more about how this event brought colonists closer to seeking independence. Explain the Boston Tea Party in your own words.
- (j) **Road Trip!** Route 66 is known as “America’s Main Street.” Check out this [site](#) and write ten facts you learn about this historic highway.
