Items to be marked with name:

- 2 Sets - Markers, Crayola **Classic** Broad tip (mark each individual marker, if possible)
- 4 - Plastic Pocket Folders (with prongs)
- 1 - Scissors, Fiskars for Kids
- 4 - Expo Dry Erase Markers
- 1 - 1 inch Binder, white with plastic sleeve on front, if possible
- 1 - Hard Plastic Supply Box, 3x6x9 (no larger!)
- 1 - Backpack, Standard Size (no wheels)
- 1 - Art shirt (old, oversized t-shirt to go over clothes)
- 1 set - EarBuds or HeadPhones (Chromebook compatible) - *the students really seem to prefer headphones for ease of use!*

Items without name:

- 2 boxes - Crayons, Crayola, 16 ct. (no larger!)
- 24 - Pencils, yellow
- 2 - Glue, Elmer's, 8 oz. bottle
- 12 - Glue sticks
- 1 - Paper towel roll
- 2 - Tissue, 180 ct.
- 1 - Baby Wipes or Hand Wipes
- 1 - Sandwich or Quart-sized Ziploc Bags
- 1 - Gallon sized Ziploc Bags

Items to Consider Keeping at School: (not required, but highly recommended)

- *A change of clothing in the event of spills or accidents
- *A pair of gym shoes for daily PE/recess

Please feel free to use the generic or store brand names for any of the above products. I listed Crayola, Fiskars and Elmers brand names as these are the brands that seem to last the longest and work the best. Most are on sale during the Back to School sales in July and August.

Please, do not send any items other than those listed above. Any items that are not required will be sent back home and are to be kept there for personal use. Thank you for your cooperation.

If you have any difficulty finding any of the items listed, please let me know and we can work out a plan for the start of the year. Sometimes these supplies move quickly in the stores, and you may be able to find them after school begins.
